この例は、One shot school visit の典型的なものであり、Greeting,Introductionでかなりの時間をかけているのもこの活用にありがちな生徒の緊張を和らげる効果を考えてである。Presentation of some slides,Questions and Answers の部分については、Game・Song・Speech など学年、学級等の実態に応じて工夫ができる。この例はAET中心でJapanese English Teacher(以下JET)の出番がないようにみえるが、JETの自評によれば十分に打ち合わせがなされていたものであり全くの"give free rein"ではない。One shot school visitは「一過性」のものであるだけに生徒のMotivationの効果に重点を置いてPlanを立てれば、効果的である。

2. Base School·Regular Shotの場合

One shot school visit と異なりいつでも必要に応じてArrangementができるしその活用の仕方も使用する言語教材のどこに重点を置いてT-Tを行うかによってProcedure も変わってくる。以下、Procedure (B)~(D)はそれぞれ重点の置き方の異なるものを例として上げた。
